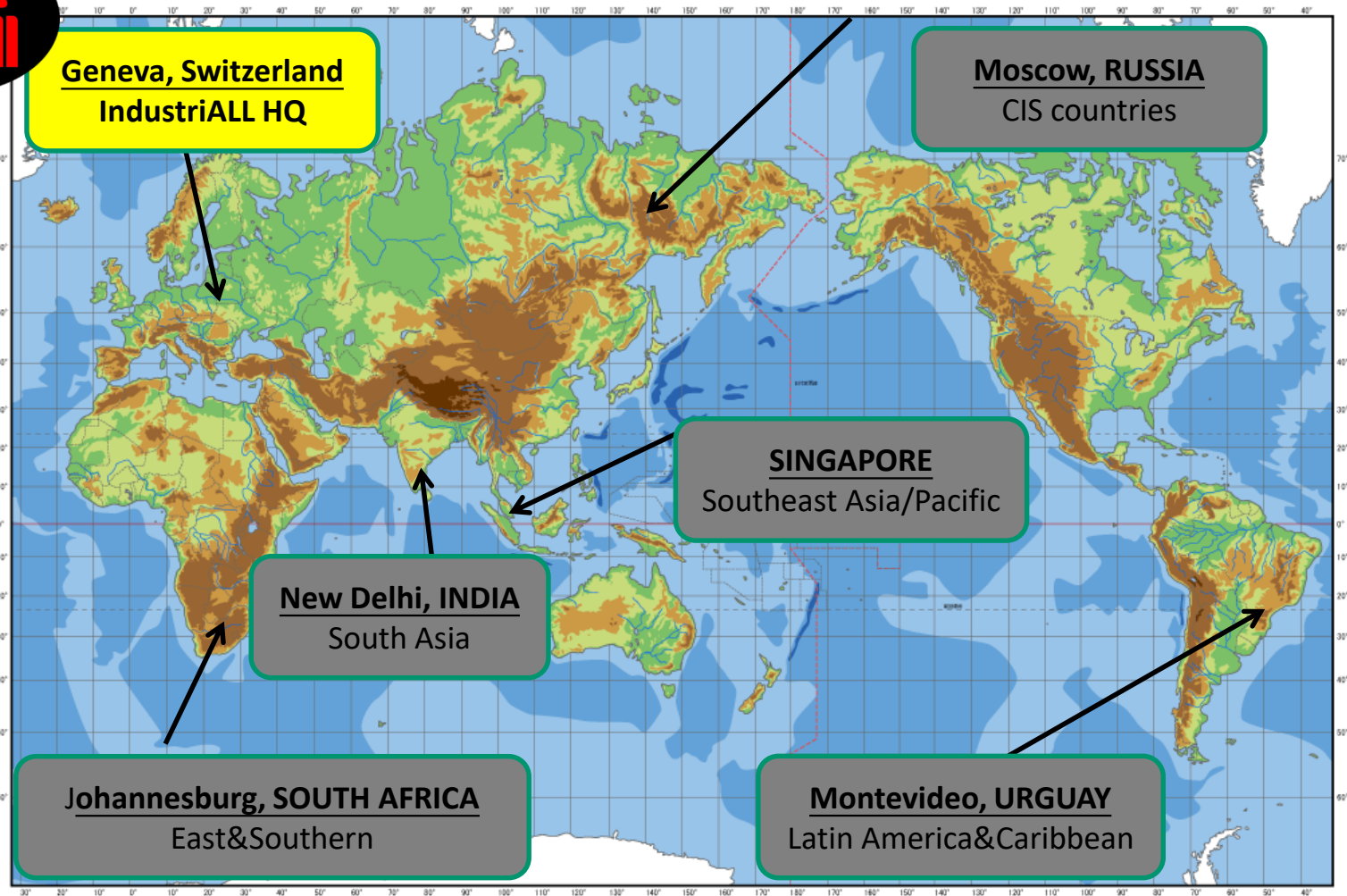
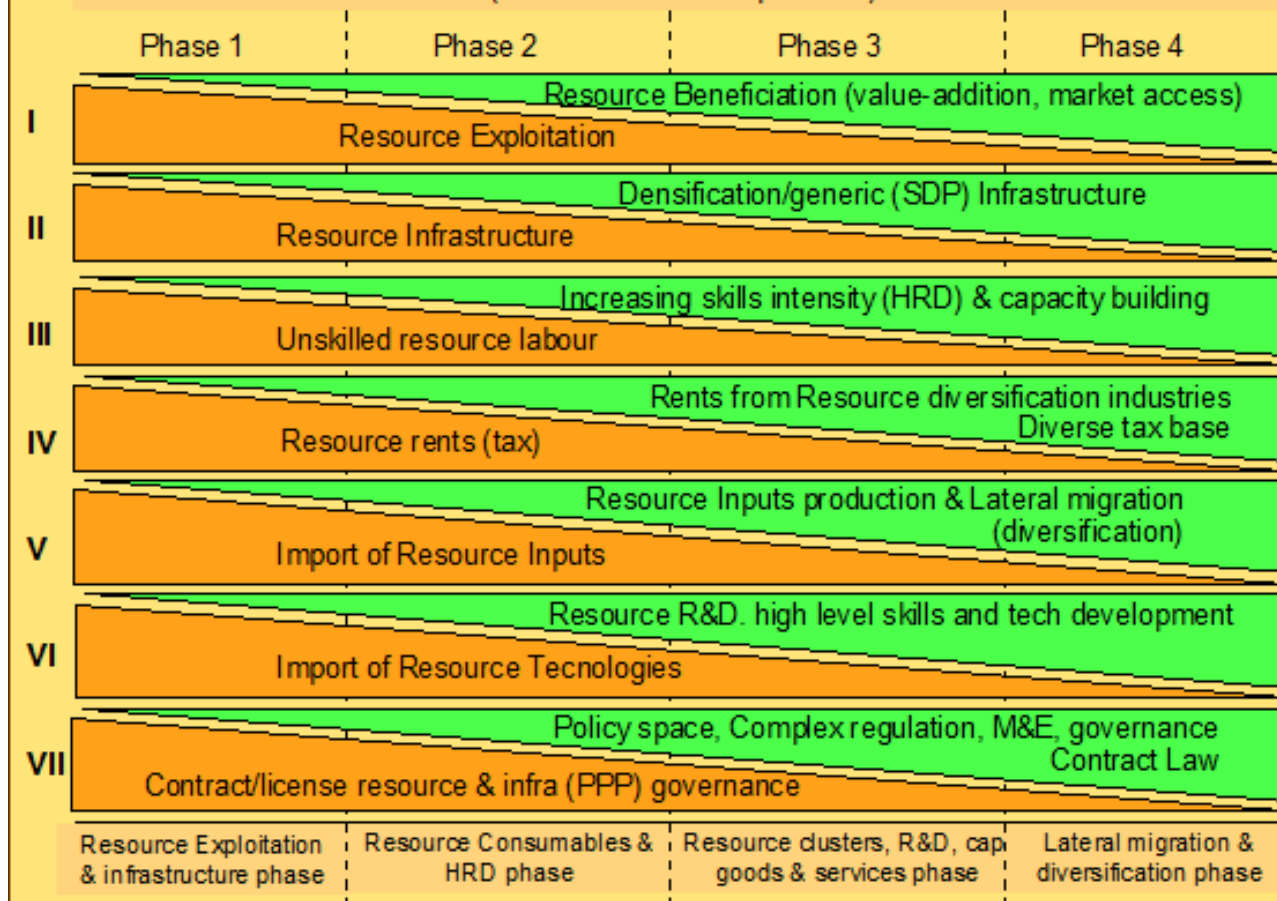


Figure 1: Schematic Resource-based African Industrialisation Phasing
